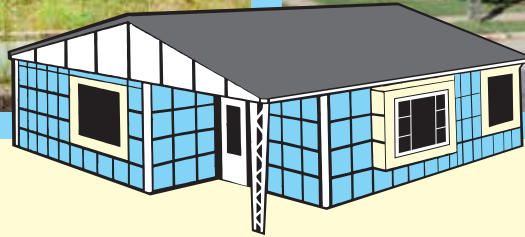


Celebrate Saving Raleigh's Historic *L*USTRON HOME!
